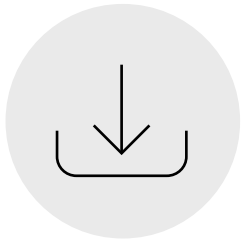
Which Factors Impact Giving?

There appears to be a substitution effect among charitable and political donations during U.S. election cycles.

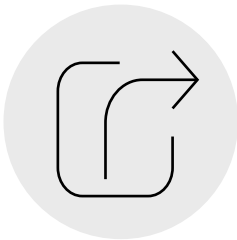

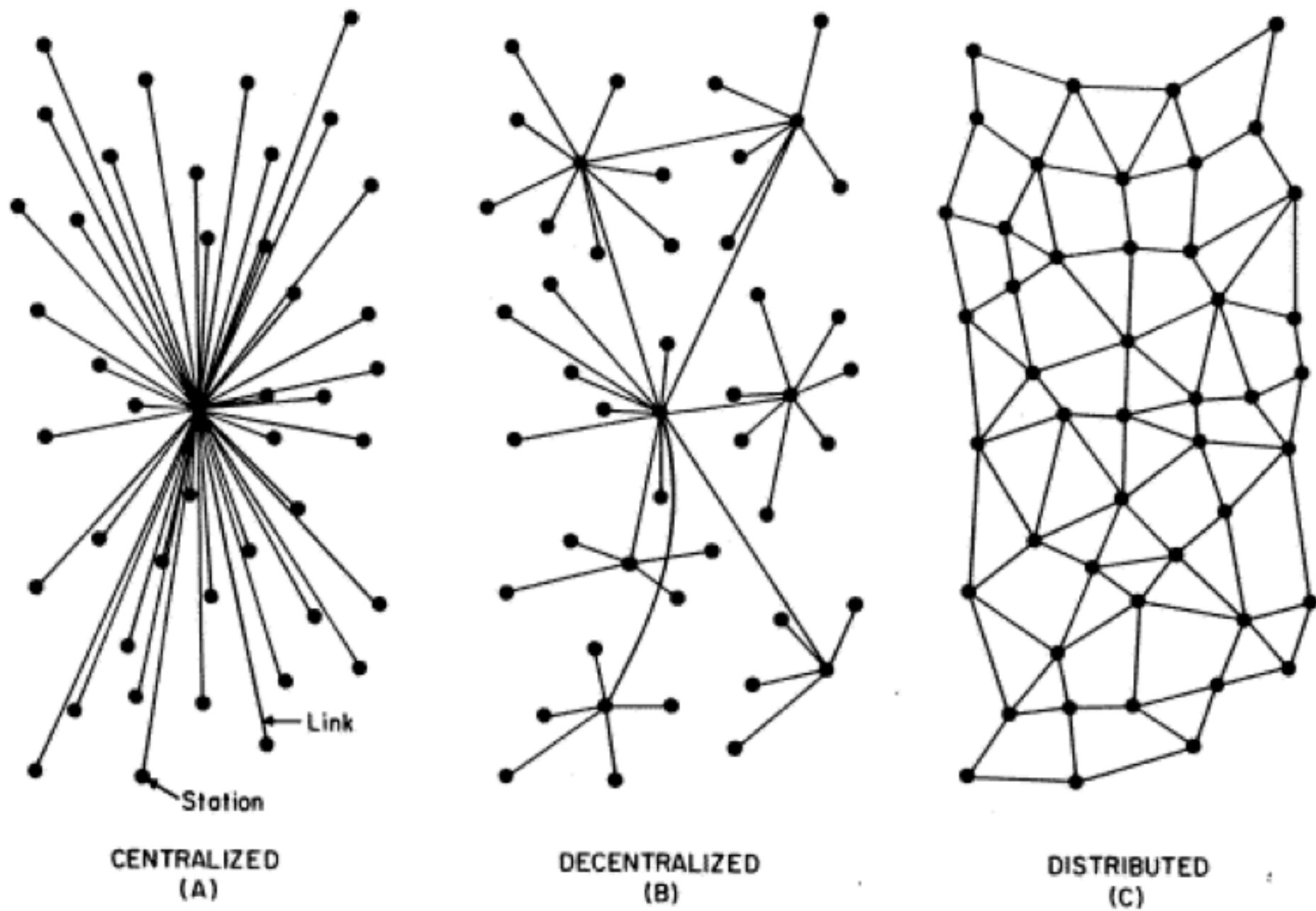


FIG. 1 - Centralized, Decentralized and Distributed Networks



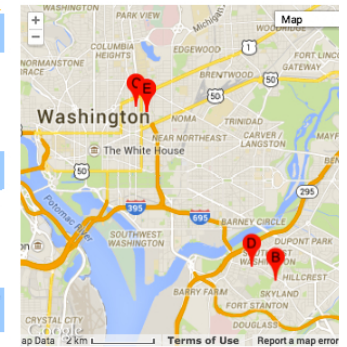

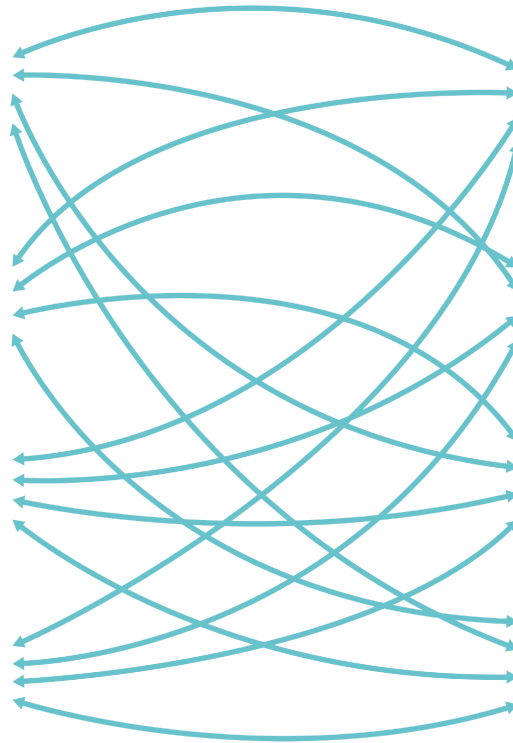

CATS is an entry level emergency shelter for homeless women. The shelter provides on-site services including breakfast, lunch and dinner, referrals, housing and medical information, substance abuse counseling, and case management. Staff are available for one-on-one peer counseling with guests on a 24-hour basis. Can accommodate 40 women. Women should come in and ask for a bed. All clients must be under case management.

The Care program allows women to stay for up to 18 months. Fees include 30% of income (no fee for one-night stays). Must be seen for an appointment by an intake worker to be put on the waiting list. The Primary Substance Abuse Program is based on the 12 steps of Alcoholics Anonymous and offers 30-to 120-day stays.
